

Lesson Programs

Young Buckaroo's

This program is for children 4-and-a-half to 7. New riders learn to groom and tack their horse and begin riding on a lead line in the care of their instructor. They learn the basics of balance and riding disguised through a game/play based program. After the riding lesson, they learn to "undress" their horse and put them away.

- There is a lesson horse available for this program at this time.
- Students must wear the proper attire.
- Riding boots - with a short heel. No tennis shoes allowed after the first Three weeks!
- Helmet - I do have one that the student can borrow for their lesson.
- Riding pants - Jeans or Breeches/Jodphers are acceptable. No shorts/ or thin stretch pants please.

Kinderponies

Riders aged 8 to 13 are old enough to learn through a series of drills and exercises designed to improve their horsemanship skills. At this age, they are ready to really begin the process of a lifelong education.

- The student first learns how to read the horse's body language correctly.
- Then how they can use their body to Effectively communicate with the horse

It's Showtime

Riders who are ready for the advanced program. Riders will begin their comprehensive riding program and will learn to utilize their skills in the show ring. This is a very intense program. Students are required to have 2 lessons a week or more if necessary. Although the competitions are generally held on the weekends and usually don't interfere with school.

- Traveling to and from the show may involve having to miss a day or two of school.
- There are no lesson horses available for this program at this time.

- The student is expected to wear the proper show attire when competing.
- The student must exercise good horsemanship as well as good sportsmanship.

Lets Ride

This program is for any rider at any level that is not interested in competing. Adults just getting into riding or who are getting back into the saddle again. As well as experienced riders who want to hone their skills, need problem resolution or want to develop a true partnership with their horse.

- There are lesson horses available for this program at this time.
- The student is required to wear the proper attire.
